CONSTRUCTION UPDATE – SYDNEY PORT BOTANY TERMINAL 3

Works Undertaken

Construction activities that have taken place on the Terminal 3 site during May 2013 are outlined below:

- Noise wall construction has continued and expected to be completed over the next couple of months
- Paving across the site has allowed delivery of the first SICTL automated stacking crane load to the Terminal 3 site
- Electrical substation and drainage works are continuing including installation of the Stormwater Quality Improvement Devices (SQIDs) has continued. The SQIDs will allow for treatment of Terminal 3 stormwater once the facility is operational.
- Services works have proceeded across the site which encompasses electrical, and potable water infrastructure
- Concrete batch plant and paving operations have continued and undertaken some
 evening works during May. All evening works have been assessed as inaudible at
 residential areas by an independent consultant. The benefits of having this plant
 on site is the ability to keep concrete trucks off the surrounding road networks and
 avoid impacting local residents and road users
- Works on the future rail siding has proceeded with ground improvements being undertaken to allow installation of track later this year.
